Surprisingly, there are so many stories in Hinduism, Buddhism and world mythologies that are similar to the Abrahamic religious stories (i.e. Judaism, Christianity and Islam). Stories such as: the world flood, crucified/sacrificed gods/sons of gods, babies sent afloat in a box in a river that finally become leaders, etc. How did these happen? If some religions/cultures borrowed from each other, then who borrowed from whom? Or did these stories really happen? As in the first book, author Indy Jane is still not sharing many of her thoughts yet...
