John Sherman, United States Senate: Sir: - In the report of proceedings of the Senate on the 9th instant, in the debate on the resolution of Senator Saulsbury, my attention has been called to the following paragraph: He (Mr. Sherman, of Ohio) believed, however, that the President had power to make arrests without the forms of law. In the case of Dr. Bachelder and the members of the Maryland Legislature, who were about to carry their State out of the Union, he thought the President was justified in making the arrests. I was a member of the Maryland Legislature in 1861, and was arrested at midnight, at my dwelling, in the city of Baltimore, about the middle of September, in that year, from which time until the 27th of November, 1862, I was confined in one or other...
