Odis is abducted from a comfortable existence at university and taken to an institution called Sisyphusa . He is told when he arrives that he is Weird and that he cannot leave until he has been Normalised . He has been fitted with an Earpiece which has a poisonous and malign voice, similar to his own, and which begins to torment his every waking moment. Encountering characters and situations loosely based on Homer s Odyssey and in a dystopian style influenced by Orwell and Kafka, we follow Odis s transformation from helpless captive to active rebel and leader. The book is imbued with dark humour and compassion for its characters and their struggles. It manages to be a satirical polemic of our own times while creating an entirely new world of Aspirati, Hysteria-Dominated Television (HDTV), I-Spy s, and Climbing Pills. It explores Mental Health themes surrounding institutionalisation, dehumanisation, self-harm, stigma, suicide...
